We will be learning about the letters of the alphabet when we look at the book "Superhero ABC", as there is a superhero for every letter of the alphabet.



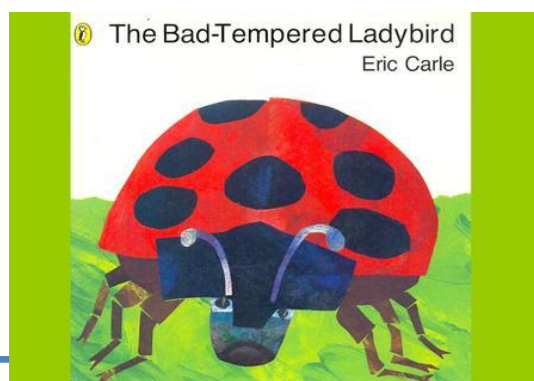
We have 'superhero' books in our Nursery library for you to select with your child, and to read together at home.
